

Dear Camper,

We are committed to the health and safety of our campers, employees, and community in light of the outbreak of COVID-19 across the country. In order to prioritize health and safety along with our commitment to our campers at Bush Park, we are monitoring federal, state and local requirements, as well as CDC guidance related to COVID-19. As you may know, the Governor has issued several Executive Orders that impact our property, including an ordered "cessation of all reservations for overnight stays" at state and private campgrounds. The Orders also require us to implement CDC guidance, which requires strict distances between staff, campers and guests that exceed our limitations of space at Bush Park and would preclude our opening the park to our annual campers.

In addition to the Governor's Executive Orders, we must follow the guidance of Middlesex County, specifically that Bush Park "remain closed to the public until the current crisis is brought under control and the state of emergency lifted by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Middlesex County."

We regret that due to these measures we must delay the opening of Bush Park at this time through June 10, or until we receive notice from the Commonwealth and Middlesex County that the distancing requirements and state of emergency are no longer in effect.

We value you as our camper, and will delay the due date of the second payment until July 15, 2020. Once the national and local crisis has been averted, we will provide you with further notice regarding a reasonable concession to the annual payment of 2020 lot rent.

We will provide further communication as soon as we have more information to share.
